Subject: Calendar of Student Enrichment Activities 2024

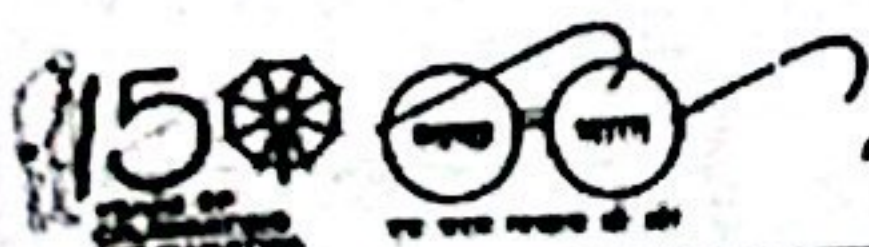

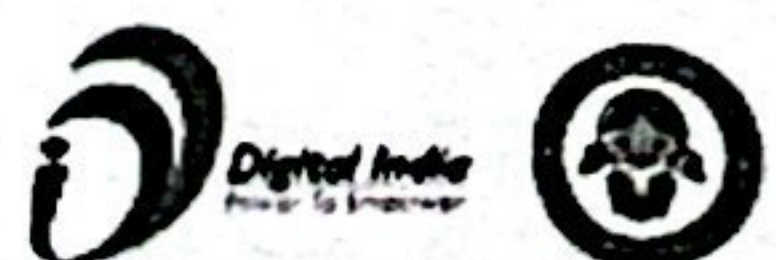

The student's participation in these activities should be reflected in their Portfolio as part of Internal Assessment.
- Share the information with the concerned stakeholders and encourage them to avail these opportunities.
